1) And they came into the other side of the lake (sea?) into the region of the Gerasenes. 2) And when (after?) he went out out of the boat immediately (suddenly?) met him out of the tombs a human being in an unclean spirit, 3) who the sub-dwelling was having in (among?) the graves and neither with a chain not yet no one was able him to bind 4) on account of the him often with foot restraints and with chains to have been bound and (on account of the) the chains to have been broken by him and (on account of the) the foot restraints to have been smashed, and no one was strong him to restrain. 5) And through all night and day in (among?) the graves and in (among?) the mountains he was shouting and (was) gashing himself with stones. 6) And having seen Jesus from a long way away (he) ran and worshiped him, 7) and having shouted with a great voice he says, "What (why?) [is] to me and to you, Jesus Son of God the most-high (One)? I adjure you by God, may you not (do not!?) torment me." 8) For he (Jesus?) was saying to him, "Come out, unclean spirit, out of the human being!" 9) And he was asking him, "What (why?) is the name to you?" And he says to him, "Legion [is] the name to me, because many we are." 10) And he was appealing (to) him many things in order that not them he might send (Gr. "apostello") outside of the region. 11) And was there toward the mountain a great herd of hogs grazing; 12) and they appealed (to) him saying, "Send (Gr. "pempo") us into the hogs in order that into them we might come into!" 13) And he turned to them (hogs?) and having come out the unclean spirits came into into the hogs, and rushed (Gr. "hormao") the herd down the cliff into the sea (lake?), about two thousand, and they were strangled (drowned?) in the sea (lake?). 14) And the ones hog-herding them fled and reported into the city and into the fields; and they went to see what is the having-happened thing. 15) And the~~y~~ come toward Jesus and they observe the being demonized one sitting being clothed and being rational, the one having had the legion and they were afraid. 16) And recounted to them the ones having seen how it happened to the one being demonized and concerning the hogs. 17) And they began to appeal (to) him to go away away from their districts. 18) And after he (Jesus?) having embarked into the boat he was appealing (to) him the having been demonized one in order that with him (?) he might be. 19) And (but?) he (Jesus?) did not permit him, but says to him, "Go back into the house of you toward the your own (kind?) and relate to them how great things the Lord to you has done and mercied you!" 20) And he went away and began to proclaim in the Decapolis how great things did to him Jesus, and all were marveling.
