

Mark 8:27-33

Rough Translation
(Alsup)

27) And went out Jesus and the disciples of him into the villages of Caesarea of Phillip. And in (on?) the way (road?) he was asking the disciples of him saying to them, "Whom me are saying the people to be?" 28) And the ones said saying that (you are) John the Baptist , and others Elijah, and others that (you are) one of the prophets. 29) And he himself was asking them, "And you (pl.) whom me are saying to be?" Having replied Peter says to him, "You are the Christ." 30) And he spoke earnestly to (rebuked?) them in order that to no one they might speak concerning him (it?).

31) And he began to teach them that it is necessary regarding the Son of Man many things to suffer and to be rejected (tested as deficient?) by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes and to be killed and after three days to rise. 32) And with openness the word he was speaking. And Peter having taken hold of him began to rebuke (?) him. 33) And the one having turned and having seen the disciples of him rebuked (?) Peter and says, "Go behind me, Satan, because you do not think the things of God but the things of mortals.
